SACRAMENTO FUNDRAISERS

The parents who got together in September to discuss how to raise funds for the Sacramento Trip in May 2013 came up with the following ideas. Several stepped forward to lead each effort, but there are still some holes to fill for heading up certain projects. Please let me know right away if you can head up or help with any of these.

Friday Ice Cream Treat (Amber) This is ongoing every Friday after school for \$1. Amber says she really needs another adult to help her dish up and serve the ice cream from 2:45-3:15. We have plenty of toppings right now, but if you could donate 1 ½ gallon plastic tub of ice cream that would be great.

½ Day Hot Lunches (Amber) Continues from last year. The next lunch is Wed., Oct. 19th and will be Mac 'n' Cheese. You could come help serve (10:30-noon) or bake or buy 2-3 doz. cookies to go with the lunch as a desert. We are looking into having a bake sale on the ½ school days right after school. We would like to get donated baked goods. Grocery stores will donate dated bakery items. We just need someone to go ask and pick them up.

Parent's Night Out (The Donnellys) December (for Christmas shopping without the kids) and February (around Valentine's Day). A kid friendly dinner will be served and they will do a craft and watch a video here at school.

Movie Day (Ashley Clark) Students will watch a movie video in school on Friday, Dec. 16th and a snack pack will be for sale for \$5. It will include: water, candy, and popcorn.

Dudley's Bread Sale (Trange) Orders will be taken monthly for loaves of Dudley's Bread. Payment will be received with order. Bread will be picked up over the weekend by Mrs. Fisher and brought to school the next week.

Free Dress @ \$1 per Item (**Need Help Here.**) Students can buy a free dress day by paying \$1 per item that they want to wear to school. Limited to one day per week. Parent volunteer would receive money as students arrive at school.

Breakfast at Applebees (Ashley Clark) This would replace the Breakfast with Santa. Students serve those eating at the restaurant (just our school families and anyone you invite). Breakfast is \$10 per person and we receive 50% of that.

Spaghetti Dinner before Open House (**Need Help Here.**) Thursday, May 17th from 6-7:30 pm is Open House. The dinner could be from 5-6pm.

Dine Outs (Lark Mayeski) 1/3 third of the profits from the Dine Outs all year come to the Sacramento Fund.
